Changes to Tentative Cease and Desist Order:

1. Modify the language on page 7 of the tentative Order as shown in underline/strikeout format below:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Cease and Desist Order R5-2007-0071 is rescinded except for enforcement purposes, and, pursuant to Water Code sections 13301 and 13267, the Discharger shall cease and desist from violating the requirements of WDR Order R5-2007-0070, or subsequently adopted renewal of the Order, and shall comply with the following:

1. The Discharger shall comply with the following time schedule to ensure compliance with the aluminum, copper, dibromochloromethane, and dichlorobromomethane effluent limitations at Section IV.A.1 contained in WDR Order R5-2007-0070, or subsequently adopted renewal of the Order as described in the above Findings. The term “project” as used below, refers to the connection of the Facility to the City of Roseville’s Dry Creek Regional Plant.
