TENTATIVE ORDER TO AMEND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. R5-2010-0104, RIO ALTO WATER DISTRICT, LAKE CALIFORNIA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, TEHAMA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order including an amended Cease and Desist Order No. R5-2010-0104 for Rio Alto Water District's Lake California Wastewater Treatment Plant. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 1 November 2012**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 1 November 2012** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative document will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 6 and 7 December 2012 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 2 October 2012** post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **3 October 2012**.
