



Notes:

1. The District proposes to serve recycled water throughout its service area for the irrigation of parks, greenbelts, and playgrounds; athletic fields; commercial landscaping, and common areas; freeway, highway, and street landscaping, and dust control.
2. The specific areas proposed for recycled water residential landscape irrigation will likely be limited to those indicated in the legend and map.
3. The District proposes to expand the irrigation area within the Van Vleck Ranch to include this area.
