HEARING PROCEDURE NOW AVAILABLE FOR DAVIS TRUST SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY

On 28 August 2014, the Assistant Executive Officer of the Central Valley Water Board issued a proposed settlement agreement (Stipulated Order) between the Central Valley Water Board Prosecution Team and David L. and Linda M. Davis Trust (Davis Trust).

This Stipulated Order was prepared in response to a memorandum that the Central Valley Water Board's Advisory Team issued to the Prosecution Team tentatively rejecting the 12 June 2014 proposed settlement of Administrative Civil Liability Complaint R5-2014-0501 (Complaint). The Prosecution Team has revised the penalty methodology for the enclosed Stipulated Order in response to the Advisory Team's comments to better explain how the proposed settlement adequately addresses the Central Valley Water Board's regulatory interests.

The Assistant Executive Officer and Davis Trust have tentatively agreed to the terms of the Stipulated Order. However, the Advisory Team has determined that the Stipulated Order should be considered by the Board. This Order is therefore tentatively scheduled to be on the 4/5 December 2014 Board hearing agenda.
