**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

concerning

**TIME SCHEDULE ORDER  
(NPDES NO. CA0079049)**

**FOR  
CITY OF DAVIS  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
YOLO COUNTY**

The City of Davis is the owner and operator of the Davis Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility), a publicly owned treatment works located at 45400 County Road 28H in Davis, California. The Facility provides sewerage services for the community of Davis. The Facility discharges up to 7.5 million gallons per day of treated wastewater to two locations, the Willow Slough Bypass, which is part of the Yolo Bypass flood control structure, and the Conaway Ranch Toe Drain, which is within the Yolo Bypass.

Discharges from the Facility are currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order R5-2013-0127 (NPDES Permit No. CA0079049), Time Schedule Order (TSO) R5-2013-0128, and TSO R5-2010-0029-02, issued by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) on 4 October 2013. TSO R5-2010-0029-02 provided the Discharger time to comply with copper, cyanide, and selenium final effluent limits contained in WDR Order R5-2013-0127. The Discharger initiated two major construction projects, an upgrade to the Facility to provide tertiary treatment and a new municipal surface water supply project (in conjunction with the City of Woodland), that when finished will allow the Discharger to comply with WDR Order R5-2013-0127. The Discharger needs additional time to complete these construction projects, and therefore, the Central Valley Water Board will consider a new time schedule for compliance with applicable final effluent limitations for copper, cyanide, and selenium contained in the WDR Order R5-2013-0127.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 27 October 2014**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

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Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **27 October 2014**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m.** on **27 October 2014** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Chair. Any party requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
