ORDER R5-2016-xxxx

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS/NPDES PERMITS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the following Board adopted Orders and Resolutions are no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

- a. WDRs Order 97-073, adopted on 25 April 1997, prescribes waste discharge requirements for the Arnold Wastewater Treatment Plant in Calaveras County. Regulation of the discharge was recently transferred to State Water Board General Order 2014-0153-DWQ-R5190, with enrollment issued on 20 January 2016. Because discharge from the facility is currently regulated under 2014-0153-DWQ-R5190, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order 97-073
- b. Waste Discharge Requirements Order 5-00-147, adopted on 16 June 2000, prescribes requirements for the discharge from the Mt. Shasta Ski Park, Siskiyou County (Facility). The Facility is comprised of a septic tank and leach field disposal system. The Facility is now regulated under Water Quality Order 2014-0153-DWQ (General Order) for discharges to land from small domestic systems with a maximum average daily flow of 100,000 gallons or less. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 5-00-147.
- c. Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2003-0165, adopted on 17 October 2003, prescribes the requirements to Support Terminals Operating Partnership, LP for the enhanced bioremediation pilot study. The pilot study has been completed and the injections are no longer necessary. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDR Order R5-2003-0165.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above orders are rescinded.
