Biggs, Colusa, Live Oak Or Willows

LOCATION: The Sacramento River Basin lies between the Sierra
Nevada Mountains in the east and the Coast Range in the
west. The Basin encompasses 27,210 square miles and
includes the entire area drained by the Sacramento River.
This includes all watersheds tributary to the Sacramento
River that are north of the Cosumnes River, and also
includes the closed basin of Goose Lake and drainage
sub-basins of Cache and Putah Creeks. The Sacramento
River, the principle water body in the Basin, meets with the
San Joaquin River approximately forty miles south of the
Sacramento area and drains into the San Francisco Bay.

DESCRIPTION: The project consists of amendments to the Basin Plan to
remove the MUN beneficial use in twelve constructed
and/or modified water bodies in the Sacramento River
Basin.

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
