Reclamation acknowledges receipt of your letter requesting an addendum of information regarding the Management Agency Agreement (MAA) Annual Work Plan and its relationship to the San Joaquin River Real-Time Management Framework. Reclamation requests an extension from October 30, 2015, to November 30, 2015, to deliver the addendum. The extension is requested to give Reclamation time needed to contact the appropriate stakeholders and gather information. Real-time management is a collaborative effort involving many stakeholders that should be included in the information gathering process.
