## WHAT'S GOING ON?

The State Water Board invites you to participate in a conference call/virtual public meeting to discuss the potential selection of California Water Rural Association (CRWA) as an Administrator for Norcal Water Works. An Administrator is a person or entity that is appointed to manage a water system in order to provide safe and affordable drinking water. This meeting is an opportunity to learn about the potential administrator, including their qualifications and proposed scope of services. At this meeting, the State Water Board will disclose any administrator conflicts of interest and provide an opportunity for public comments and questions.

This meeting is part of the Safe and Affordable Funding for Equity and Resilience (SAFER) program. The SAFER program was designed to ensure Californians who lack safe and affordable drinking water receive it as quickly as possible. The SAFER program is helping water systems achieve this goal through a set of tools, funding sources, and regulatory authorities, such as the appointment of an Administrator.
