#### PURPOSE

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) invites you to attend a meeting to learn about California Rural Water Association/Specialized Utility Services Program, Inc. (CRWA/SUSP) as a potential administrator to the Norcal Water Works water system (System).

An administrator is a person or entity that is appointed to partially or completely manage a designated water system in order to provide an adequate supply of safe and affordable drinking water. The purpose of this meeting is to provide information on the following:

- Current status of drinking water in Norcal Water Works.
- Purpose and role of an administrator.
- Administrator qualifications, conflicts of interest, and scope of work.

The meeting will also include an opportunity for the public to ask questions and provide comments. The public can submit questions and comments through **December 17, 2020**.

### BACKGROUND

On July 9, 2020, the State Water Board, in collaboration with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), designated Norcal Water Works as a water system in need of an administrator because it has not consistently provided an adequate supply of affordable, safe drinking water to its customers. Failure to collect monthly routine bacteriological samples from September 2019 to June 2020; failure to employ a water system operator; and various other violations and technical, managerial, and financial concerns culminated in the State Water Board's 2020 designation of the System as a system in need of an administrator.

The State Water Board proposes appointing an administrator for the System to manage the water system. All actions taken by an administrator are required to be in the best interest of the community served by the water system and include the following:

- Developing access to an adequate supply of safe and affordable drinking water.
- Holding public meetings at least every three months.

Any ratepayer, renter, or property owner who receives water from a designated water system can submit a petition to the State Water Board to reverse or modify an administrator decision or to replace an administrator. A description of this process and the administrator authority is contained in Health and Safety Code Section 116686 and in the State Water Board's Administrator Policy Handbook (Sept. 2019).

#### Information on Proposed Administrator

#### NAME OF ADMINISTRATOR

CRWA/SUSP has been identified as a viable candidate to be appointed as an administrator of the System. Their qualifications include:

- Staff has combined 150 years' experience in water system management and operation.
- Currently provides operational and management services to eight communities.
- Experience with enabling communities to maintain their overall compliance in Technical, Managerial, and Financial capacity.

### **SCOPE OF APPOINTMENT & SERVICES PROVIDED**

This administrator will be a Full-Scope Administrator as defined in the <u>Administrator Policy Handbook</u> available online at bit.ly/SAFER\_Administrator

#### **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

No conflict of interest has been found by the State Water Board or reported by CRWA/SUSP at this time. If at any time a proposed action would create a conflict of interest, an administrator is required to provide written notice the State Water Board in addition to all ratepayers, renters and property owners, who receive water service from the designated water system 30 days prior to taking the action.
