Since I own two disadvantaged communities, the huge fees we pay, are being absorbed by me(a single mother) and my child and can not be passed on to the communities. Some people have as little as 800/ mo to live off of. I have elderly, vets and generally people who would otherwise have no options to live elsewhere. On U wanna Camp, some people can only pay 250/month for a space and I have not been able to give them an increase for 7+ years. I proposed an increase of 25\$ a month and the water fees, requirements for testing, the testing fees have increased and tripled and quadrupled. Garbage has increased, electricity has gone up and their income levels have remained the same or been reduced by the government. My other community is in Willits and no increases have been made for the same period of time.
