

## **Cluster 1 Cleanup Near Completion; Cluster 2 to Begin**

The Carousel Community cleanup began on May 9, 2016. Cluster 1 residents (nine homes that are bound by 248th Street to the north, 249th Street to the south and Neptune Avenue to the west) were the first group to be temporarily relocated while excavation and restoration activities are being completed.

After approximately 18 weeks, Cluster 1 residents will move back into their homes with clean front and back yards. The temporary relocation process begins in late August for Cluster 2 residents (ten properties located on E. 248th Street, Ravenna, E. 249th Street, and Panama Avenue). ### **What you can expect:**

#### **Sound Reduction Walls**

Sound reduction walls will be put up around Cluster 2 during the last week of August to reduce any excessive noise from the cleanup activities. Traffic control plan will be established. The public information and traffic signage will be posted on the exterior of the sound reduction walls.

#### **Security**

Due to heavy equipment used for the cleanup, no one will be allowed to enter the secured area without a security badge. There will be onsite security provided during all hours that crew members are not present.

## Large Construction Equipment and Vehicles

Excavators and drill rigs will be used during the cleanup. There will be crew members in place for your safety while equipment is being moved.

## Traffic

Subject to approval of the draft Traffic Control Plan by the City of Carson, traffic flow will be impacted as follows:

- The north side of E. 249th Street (between Neptune and Lagoon) will be blocked with sound attenuation panels from west of Lagoon to Panama Avenue, and traffic flow on E. 249th Street will be one-way eastbound.
- The west side of Panama Avenue will be blocked with sound attenuation panels from E. 249th Street approximately 300 feet to the north, and traffic flow on Panama Avenue will be one-way northbound.
- The intersection of E. 248th Street and Ravenna Avenue will be closed (full closure).
- There will be no parking on E. 248th Street from Neptune Avenue to the sound attenuation enclosure.
- There will be no parking on E. 249th Street from Lagoon Avenue approximately 250 feet to the west.
- There will be no parking on Ravenna Avenue extending from E. 248th Street approximately 200 feet to the north.
- There will be no parking on Panama Avenue from E. 249th Street approximately 300 feet to the north.

These traffic impacts are subject to change based on the City's review of the Traffic Control Plan.


