**MODOC COUNTY**

I'SOT Inc. (Discharger) owns and operates a geothermal fluid heat exchange system and discharges spent fluid into the Pit River. Spent fluid passes through a series of activated carbon vessels to remove mercury prior to discharge. The Discharger's mailing address is 22416 Highway 299 E., Canby, CA 96015. The discharge is regulated under an existing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The Discharger submitted a Report of Waste Discharge and requested renewal of the existing NPDES permit. Staff recommends the Regional Water Quality Control Board adopt the NPDES permit regulating the discharge from the facility.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Regional Board meeting that is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **13 August 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. CA0084859 was issued on 13 July 2007. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by noon on **13 August 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon

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on 13 August 2007 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
