The City Of Colfax (Discharger) owns and operates a municipal wastewater treatment plant that provides sewerage service for approximately 1,800 people, with no significant industrial users. This Resolution amends the monitoring and reporting requirements to remove excessive monitoring requirements for priority pollutants in sludge, and clarifies appropriate metals monitoring.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **noon on 28 February 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Resolution to Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2007-0130 was issued on 28 January 2008. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **noon on 28 February 2008**. Written materials submitted after this time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
