NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP

Concerning

AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANS FOR THE SACRAMENTO RIVER AND SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BASINS AND TULARE LAKE BASIN TO ESTABLISH A REGION-WIDE PROCESS FOR EVALUATING THE MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC SUPPLY (MUN) BENEFICIAL USE IN AGRICULTURALLY DOMINATED SURFACE WATER BODIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board or Board) will hold a public workshop regarding the development of an amendment (the "Proposed Amendment") that would amend the Water Quality Control Plans for both the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and for the Tulare Lake Basin (the "Basin Plans"). The Proposed Amendment would establish a region-wide process for evaluating the Municipal and Domestic Supply (MUN) beneficial use in agriculturally dominated surface water bodies.

The Central Valley Water Board has scheduled to conduct the workshop at the Board's meeting in Fresno, which will be held at the following date and location:

Though the Board may provide direction to Board staff, the Board will not take action on the Proposed Amendment at the April workshop. Oral comments will be limited in time by the Board Chair. Groups are encouraged to designate a spokesperson.
