In addition, the proposed project would include a 0.59. acre parcel north of Aralia Drive that would be turned into a basin to replace the existing concrete dissipater structure. Activities: The outlet structure on the southeast side of the site, including the concrete headwall and rip-rap will be removed and replaced with a 3'x6' concrete storm drain that will be constructed along the project site frontage on Lincoln Avenue to Gibson Street, then northwest along the project site frontage on Gibson Street to the north side of Aralia Drive where it will enter the project site and connect to an earthen infiltration basin to be constructed. The existing trapezoidal concrete channel with energy dissipaters north of Aralia Drive will be removed. An earthen infiltration basin will be constructed on the parcel northwest of Aralia Drive, northeast of Gibson Street and southeast of the existing Riverside Canal. The earthen basin will be approximately 0.51 acre, the basin bottom will be 0.20 acre, and 5:1 side slopes will be 0.30 acre.
