A review of the Final Draft State Wide, 20x2020 Plan suggest that this was well thought out. I can appreciate the time and effort that has done into preparing this document. Having said that; I have only a couple of comments.

- Under **Plan Scale & Scope** it states, "This 20x2020 Plan addresses only "urban water use and conversations". I question how that would apply consistently to all factors/ corporations and factories verses residential use that impedes, or use the States water supply.

It is my opinion that some of the worse offenders of wasting water come from the factories and corporations within our City limits, rather that from urban use.

- Page 7, it gives a short blurb regarding public impute, but no where was there a reference as to where to find the public comments at that point. As a lay person I was interested in comparing what other citizens had to say.

I feel that a side note advising where the public impute were located was needed on p.7. If I had just over looked that portion I am requesting that that be made available for review.

- I felt that the formatting was odd and took away from concentration of the actually plan, which addresses how we as a State can cut back on water use.

How do you define the wording, "Work Shop" process? In all fairness I got the feeling that the public participation was being watered down, with the public notice just showing up this last week! The fact that the usual methods for public comments was limited; to E-Mail, rather that written, fax or E-mail. Lucky for me I had a fax no to use.
