

# BACKGROUND

Beginning in Spring 2007, the Water Boards began the process to update their Strategic Plan by holding statewide and regional board outreach sessions. These sessions consisted of a Stakeholder Summit, a Staff Summit and Regional Board Outreach Meetings. From these sessions, the Water Boards collected and organized the input received and identified common themes representing both environmental and organizational areas of focus for the Water Boards.
