Economic Considerations

- Porter-Cologne
 - When adopting new or revised water quality objectives
 - must “consider economics” (CWC §13241)
 - When adopting an Agricultural Water Quality Control Plan (CWC § 13141)
 - Estimate Total Costs of Program
 - Identify potential funding sources

Economics (Con't)

- CEQA
 - Adoption of a rule or regulation requiring the installation of pollution control equipment, or a performance standard or treatment requirement (CEQA §21159)
