Travel Management Rule (TMR)

"USFS is mandated to retain no more roads or routes than it anticipates having sufficient funding to appropriately maintain during its 5-year funding cycle. The TMR is implemented through Forest Service Manuals (FSM) 2350, 7700, and 7710 and Forest Service Handbook (FSH) 7709.55"

Comment:

In the USFS Travel Management Plans that I studied, the "mandate to retain no more roads or routes than it anticipates having sufficient funding to appropriately maintain during its 5-year funding cycle" was NOT included. The accuracy of this statement must be confirmed or delete the statement.
