**JUSTIFICATION DEFINITIONS:**

High Growth = Areas that grew 25% or more from 2000 to 2010 and have a population density of 1,000 people per square mile.

Federal Endangered Species = Chinook Salmon, Coho Salmon, and/or Steelhead Trout and having a 2010 Census population of 5,000 or more.
