

Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund Program

Fund Update: Reimbursements Released to Accounting Summary

The Underground Storage Tank (UST) Cleanup Fund Program at the State Water Resources Control Board processes reimbursement requests (RRs) received from eligible claimants and makes payment for eligible costs from its various accounts. The accounts included in this update consist of General Tanks, Commingled Plume Account, Expedited Claim Account Program, and the School District Account.

The following table lists both the total dollar amount and number of RRs processed and sent to the Accounting Office for payment in fiscal year 2023-24. Processed RRs may use prior funding years for payment. To provide more detailed data, RR totals are also broken down by the funding year of each individual account (where applicable). This information is updated as of February 29, 2024.
