RENOTICE OF APPLICATION 31743 AND RELATED PETITIONS FOR CHANGE FOR LICENSES 3697 (APPLICATION 10795), 4216 (APPLICATION 14178), 4729A (APPLICATION 13684A), AND 5559 (APPLICATION 13384)

COUNTY: Sonoma

STREAM SYSTEM: Russian River

The subject application and related petitions are being renoticed to correct inaccuracies contained in the original notice issued on August 3, 2015. Specifically, estimated face values previously reported for the subject licenses are pending, and as such have been removed from the notice. Additionally, the total amount of water to be diverted pursuant to the subject application and the amended licenses has been revised to accurately reflect the value requested by the applicant/petitioner. The time period allowed for filing written protests against approval of the subject application and related petitions has been extended accordingly.

On January 23, 2009, Gallo Glass Company – Twin Valley Ranch filed an application to appropriate water by permit and related petitions for change on four existing licenses (collectively, the Gallo Glass Company – Twin Valley Ranch project) with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division). The change petitions add place of use, purposes of use, and correct the point of diversion location related to vineyard operations. The application is for diversion of water to offstream storage, with the point of diversion, place of use, and purposes of use being the same as those described in the subject change petitions.

On October 24, 2014, Gallo Glass Company – Twin Valley Ranch amended the subject application and change petitions to (i) include water releases for the enhancement of fish and wildlife resources in Porter Creek, and (ii) request that the total amount to be diverted pursuant to the subject application and licenses not exceed 750 acre-feet per year. The project is supported by the National Marine Fisheries Service and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
