Paradise Irrigation District, c/o Paula Whealen, Wagner & Bonsignore, 444 North Third St, Sacramento, CA 95814 has filed a petition for extension of time and a petition for change, seeking to add direct diversion as a method of diversion, add a point of diversion which is currently used for diversion to storage as a point of direct diversion also, add hydropower as a purpose of use, and to add the service areas of Paradise Pines, Old Magalia and Lime Saddle Districts of the Del Oro Water Company within Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 24, T21N, R3E; Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, and 30, T21N, R4E; Sections 9, 17, 20, 29, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, T22N, R3E; Sections 5, 8, 17, 20, 29, 31, and 32, T22N, R4E; Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35, and 36, T23N, R3E; and Sections 18, 19, 29, 30, 31, and 32, T23N, R4E; all within MDB&M to the place of use.
