The Department of Water Resources (DWR), Nancy Quan, 1416 Ninth Street, Sacramento, CA 94236-0001, has filed petitions for change to add the Oak Flat Water District (Oak Flat), a State Water Project long-term contractor, to the authorized place of use for the State Water Project specified in Permits 16478, 16479, 16481, and 16482 (Applications 5630, 14443, 14445A, and 17512). The Oak Flat service area was omitted from the original DWR permit maps showing the proposed SWP place of use.
