Permit 12167 currently allows direct diversion from Pardee Reservoir, and this petition requests the addition of diversion to offstream storage from the same point of diversion. The proposed point of rediversion/point of storage will be at the existing Jackson Creek Dam located within the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 9, T5N, R10E, MDB&M.
