NOTICE OF PETITIONS FOR CHANGE FOR LICENSES 1050, 2814, 3109, 3110, AND 9794 (APPLICATIONS 534, 1056, 1203, 1413, AND 15572) AND PERMIT 19400 (APPLICATION 25727)

COUNTIES: Sacramento and Sutter STREAM SYSTEM: Sacramento River, Natomas Cross Canal, Reclamation District No. 1000 Drains

Natomas Central Mutual Water Company (Petitioner or NCMWC) filed petitions for change, seeking to add a point of diversion (the Sankey diversion facility) to its five water right Licenses 1050, 2814, 3109, 3110, and 9794, and its water right Permit 19400. The new point of diversion is necessary pursuant to the American Basin Fish Screen and Habitat Improvement Project.
