NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE FOR PERMIT 2452 (APPLICATION 3544)

COUNTY: Siskiyou STREAM SYSTEM: Shasta River

Montague Water Conservation District has filed a temporary urgency change petition, pursuant to Water Code Sections 1435 and 1707, with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). The petition requests to temporarily:

- Add a new Point of Diversion (City Diversion) on the Shasta River near the City of Montague (City);
- Add Municipal and Fish and Wildlife Preservation and Enhancement as beneficial uses;
- Add the boundaries of the City, and the Shasta River from Dwinnell Dam to the City Diversion, as authorized places of use;
- · Add direct diversion as an authorized method of diversion; and
- Dedicate up to 1.5 cubic feet per second (cfs) to instream beneficial use within the reach of the Shasta River added as an authorized place of use.
