These topics include the feasibility of the proposed project, the statewide balancing of interests, and how the proposed project would be funded. The undersigned parties request that the materials listed below³ be stricken from Dr. Thornberg's testimony. The testimony is outside the scope of Part 1 as determined by the Hearing Officers and is also not responsive to Rebuttal testimony provided by protestants.

<u>Thornberg Testimony Requested Stricken:</u>

- p. 34, lines 2-3 ("or underestimate the economic benefits of the WaterFix")
- p. 34, lines 5-8 ("However, the perceived negative economic impact is very small, while the expected benefits to the local economy due to the WaterFix will be very high (construction could add substantial numbers of jobs and spending to the Delta economy).")
- p.34, lines 13-14 ("The funding for each respective construction project would actually come from different sources and could work together, as a result.")
- p. 34, lines 15-17 ("Fourth, Dr. Michael significantly underestimates the high impacts on economic output, jobs, and wages to the whole economy of California due to the multiplier effects from over \$15 billion in WaterFix construction and operations spending.")
