On February 7, 2018, DWR announced that it would issue a draft supplemental environmental impact report in June 2018 and a final supplement in October 2018. In accordance with the Notice of Public Hearing, this hearing should be stayed pending completion of the CEQA process and the supplemental environmental impact report.
