Deirdre Des Jardins, principal at California Water Research ("California Water Research") provides this argument supporting Doug Obegi's use of authoritative reference papers and reports in cross-examination of DWR's witnesses. Since 1967, the California Evidence Code (CEC) has allowed texts to be used on cross-examination to highlight an expert's weaknesses when the expert testifies contrary to established authority in the field. Evidence Code 721, subdivision (b)(1) provides that the cross-examiner could read excerpts from "learned treatises" as long as the expert had referred to, considered, or relied on the publication when forming his or her opinion, or if the publication had been admitted in evidence.

In 1997, subdivision (b)(3) was added to Evidence Code section 721. It allows an expert to be cross-examined with several types of publications, not just learned treatises. The use of a publication is permitted on cross-examination, even when the

expert on the stand does not recognize the publication, so long as either the expert being cross-examined or another expert recognizes the document as authoritative.

Doug Obegi's use of references during cross-examination was consistent with Evidence Code 721 (b)(3.)
