Dear Hearing Chair Doduc and Hearing Co-Chair Marcus:

On April 6, 2018, our office, for the Sacramento Valley Water Users group ("SVWU"), served a subpoena duces tecum on petitioner Department of Water Resources ("DWR"). The subpoena demanded production of certain numerical results from DWR's CalSim modeling by noon on April 16, 2018. The demanded results are, for a number of key hydrologic parameters, the results from the base and with-action scenarios for DWR's CWF H3+, which DWR's witnesses have testified is now the "adopted project" in this hearing, as well as comparisons of those base and with-action scenarios. Today, two hours after the deadline for production, DWR filed a response to the subpoena that is styled as an objection, motion for protective order and motion to quash the subpoena. DWR did not produce any of the CWF H3+ modeling results that are subject to the subpoena.

To address the issues raised by DWR's response and to aid the Hearing Officers in ruling on DWR's objection/motion, SVWU respectfully requests leave to file a response to DWR no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, April 18, 2018.
