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
1           Upon reading and considering the unopposed Ex Parte Application for Judgment  
2 requesting the validation and confirmation of Plaintiff Terra Bella Irrigation District's (District)  
3 certain contract entitled "UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF  
4 RECLAMATION, CENTRAL VALLEY PROJECT, CALIFORNIA, CONTRACT BETWEEN  
5 THE UNITED STATES AND TERRA BELLA IRRIGATION DISTRICT PROVIDING FOR  
6 PROJECT WATER SERVICE FROM FRIANT DIVISION AND FOR FACILITIES  
7 REPAYMENT," CONTRACT NO. 175r-2446D (hereinafter referred to as the "Repayment  
8 Contract"), due proof having been made by satisfactory evidence submitted to the Court that the  
9 District caused this action to be brought within the proper time; that Summons was issued herein  
10 and was duly published pursuant to Section 6063 of the California Government Code in the  
11 *Valley Voice*, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Tulare, State of  
12 California, and designated by this Court; that jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and  
13 of all persons interested has been duly obtained by this Court and is complete; that no person  
14 appeared in said action to contest the validity of the contract involved in said action or any  
15 proceeding taken for the authorization of approval thereof or any other matters involved in said  
16 proceedings.

17           And it further appearing that the time for such appearances and contest has expired and  
18 the default of all defendants has been duly entered, it is now, upon application of the District,  
19 ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED AS FOLLOWS THAT:

20 1.       The proceedings leading up to, and including, the authorization of the execution and the  
21 approval of the Repayment Contract by the DISTRICT's Board of Directors, are hereby  
22 validated and confirmed, and each and all provisions of the Repayment Contract are hereby  
23 approved, confirmed and declared lawful, valid and upon execution binding upon the respective  
24 parties thereto.

25 2.       All persons are permanently enjoined from the institution of any action or proceeding  
26 raising any issue as to which this judgment is binding and conclusive.
