Dear Chair Marcus and Member Doduc:

On behalf of the parties to the California WaterFix Hearing represented by Downey Brand LLP (the "Downey Brand Parties"), we provide our proposed groupings for cross-examination of Petitioners' witnesses during Part 1A of the California WaterFix Hearing.

The Downey Brand Parties join in the proposal submitted by the Sacramento Valley Water Users ("SVWU") regarding cross-examination groupings. In addition, we propose the following order and grouping of the remaining Downey Brand Parties.

1. Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority and the agencies within its service area will coordinate to present a single cross-examination and propose to immediately follow the SVWU cross-examination.
2. North Delta Water Agency and its member agencies will coordinate to present a single cross-examination and propose to immediately follow the Tehama-Colusa Canal Authority cross-examination.
3. Brannan-Andrus Levee Maintenance District; Reclamation District 407, Reclamation District 2067, Reclamation District 317, Reclamation District 551, Reclamation District 563, Reclamation District 150, and Reclamation District 2098 (collectively the "Delta Flood Control Group") will coordinate to present a single cross-examination and propose to immediately follow the North Delta Water Agency cross-examination.
