The Associated General Contractors of California is more than 1,000 members strong who are contractors, specialty, and associate member companies and represent the full spectrum of the construction industry.

We support the California WaterFix because it will update our outdated statewide water distribution infrastructure by creating a modern water pipeline below ground relying on the most innovative technologies and engineering practices.

CA WaterFix will protect our precious water supplies from major earthquakes, floods and natural disasters.

It will create nearly 119,000 new construction jobs and \$7 billion in employee compensation. The result of an updated and reliable water delivery system will protect nearly one million statewide jobs.

WaterFix will also offer the state flexibility to capture and store more water during times of heavy rainfall. With WaterFix, we will be able to keep supplies steady as the state and economy grow.
