I understand the need for conservation but ask that the mandatory reductions be more equitable. For example, I do not believe that San Diego County that has 99.5% of its required reserves should be treated the same as counties that have a reserve shortfall. I further believe there should be some flexibility in the base year; I replaced turf with artificial grass in 2012 but receive no credit for it. Lastly there should be some creativity in the establishment of the zones. I live in a house with a small lot which if in Oceanside or San Diego would have a required reduction less than 20%. But because I am in a district with Rancho Santa Fe, my required reduction is 36%. I respectfully ask that you correct these inequities.
