Please reverse the decision to relax the D-1641 March requirements for inflows to San Francisco Bay and ensure that these flows critical to the continued existence of Delta smelt, winter-run Chinook salmon and other species are actually provided.

Please reverse the decision to partly relax the D-1641 limits on export pumping, in order to prevent devastating impacts on the last remaining Delta smelt and winter-run salmon.

Extinction of these species is possible if you don't act appropriately to save them.
