**Subject:** Please restore freshwater flow requirements for San Francisco Bay Estuary

Dear State Water Resources Control Board :

I live in Oakland, CA and I care about the fish and wildlife of the San Francisco Estuary. I understand that the State Water Board has eliminated important freshwater flow protections for these species. I urge the Board to:

1. Restore the freshwater flow requirements (in Board order D-1641) for March and ensure that these flows, which are critical to the continued existence of several fish species and the general health of our San Francisco Bay Estuary, are actually provided.
2. Reject new petitions seeking suspension of environmental protections for freshwater flows in March and April.

The drought is affecting all residents, as well as wildlife and fish. We need equal protection for all.
