NOTICE OF POTENTIAL CURTAILMENT OF JUNIOR PRIORITY CLASS RIGHTS IN THE SCOTT RIVER WATERSHED SUBJECT TO DECREE NO. 30662

The notice is applicable for only junior priority class rights identified by the Scott River Adjudication, Decree No. 30662 (Decree) as either: (1) a Priority 2 Class Right in Schedule D-4 of the Decree, (2) a Post-1914 Appropriative Right in Schedule E of the Decree, or (3) a "Surplus Class" right in the Decree. The Division of Water Rights (Division) is providing this advance notice to advise junior priority class diverters of the probability for curtailment if weather conditions remain the same. To obtain the most up-to-date information on potential curtailments for junior priority class rights, the Division maintains information on its drought web page. The web page is regularly updated to provide a current hydrograph of the Scott River flow near Fort Jones and the US Forest Service senior instream flow right as defined by Paragraph 45 of the Decree. Upon issuance of a curtailment notice from the Division, the Decree requires that you cease diverting water under your junior priority class right.
