Under the Operations Agreement, the conservation account (which is also limited to a 200,000 acre-foot maximum), 92,000 acre-feet have been lost due to ongoing flood control operations since November, limiting the District's ability to use water in this account to 138,000 acre-feet (which may be further reduced as flood control conditions continue).

Some numbers have changed because Tulloch consumptive use was further restrained by actual daily withdrawals (versus a monthly constraint). Numbers can also change when additional data changes the thirty day average used to determine when refill storage is occurring, or there is a change in annual minimum elevation as year progresses, etc.
