PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

The **Public Hearing** formerly scheduled to commence on **March 11, 2019**, as identified in the **January 29, 2019 [Notice of Public Hearing](#)**, is **cancelled**.

On October 19, 2018, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Division of Water Rights issued an Administrative Civil Liability Complaint against Lewis Evans (Respondent) for the alleged violation of annual water use reporting requirements. The State Water Board scheduled a hearing at the request of the Respondent to receive evidence relevant to determining whether the Respondent violated regulations or the terms or conditions of any permit or license requiring the filing of a Progress Report by Permittee or Report of Licensee and, if a violation occurred, to determine the amount of administrative civil liability and adopt an order imposing civil liability upon the Respondent.

On February 4, 2019, the Prosecution Team withdrew the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint against the Respondent. Accordingly, no hearing is required to be held on this matter, and the hearing is **hereby cancelled**.
