Re: Request for One Month Extension of Hearing Date – Cachuma Project Revised Draft Order

Dear Ms. Townsend:

By correspondence dated April 12, 2019, the State Water Resources Control Board extended the deadline to May 29, 2019 for submitting comments on the revised draft order amending water rights permits for the Cachuma Project (Permits 11308 and 11310). The Cachuma Conservation Release Board, the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, the City of Lompoc, and the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, Improvement District No. 1 (collectively, the "Local Interests") appreciate that extension.

In view of the significant changes contained in the revised draft order, the Local Interests intend to submit substantial comments by the May 29 deadline. However, under the current schedule, the State Board will have only three (3) business days between the comment deadline and the June 4 meeting date to review and address the comments received from the Local Interests and other parties, and make any necessary changes to the final order.<sup>1</sup> While we appreciate the State Board's efforts to bring this matter to conclusion, we believe more than three days are needed for the State Board to meaningfully consider and address our comments in producing a final order.

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Accordingly, the Local Interests request that the meeting date for the State Board's consideration of the Cachuma Project final order be extended at least 30 days. Thank you for your attention to this issue.
