### **Employment and Experience**

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August 18, 2010 to Present: Water Resource Control Engineer, Enforcement Unit 4, Division of Water Rights, State Water Resources Control Board, Sacramento.

Duties include: Performing statewide inspections of municipal, agricultural, industrial and recreational water projects to determine compliance with terms and conditions of water right permits and licenses. Conducting investigations throughout the north coast, as defined by the Policy for Maintaining Instream Flows in Northern California Coastal Stream, to identify and inspect water diversions without a known basis of right. Duties performed during investigations and inspections include taking field measurements and documenting observations in order to determine if a reservoir or other diversion is collecting water subject the State Water Board's permitting authority and/or verify any claimed basis of right. Field measurements collected include, but are not limited to, determining dam height, GPS of the water surface area and stream channels, GPS of the place of use, flow measurements, inspection of supplemental water sources, and general observations. The information on file with the Division and collected during the field inspection is used to compile an inspection report, including maps and photos, and provide recommendations based on the findings of the investigation. When enforcement action is pursued duties include preparing a notice of proposed cease and desist order and/or administrative civil liability complaint for review by senior and upper management.

Summer 2007 and 2008: Survey Technician, Humboldt County Department of Public Works, Eureka.

Conducted preliminary survey of project area to determine equipment needed, finding existing benchmarks and monuments, generating project maps, establish a work timeline, and identify and mitigate potential hazards. When surveying a project my duties included setting up total station backsights, using a tape measure to get on target as rodman, conducting level lines (one in excess of four miles), and satellite GPS surveying on long road stretches.
