A field investigation of the project under this application will be made by the Division of Water Rights on the date shown below.

Water Code Section 1345 requires the Division of Water Rights to investigate all minor applications against which there are unresolved protests. If the protests cannot be resolved during the field investigation, a staff analysis will be prepared and mailed to all parties concerned. The analysis will summarize the factual situation and review all evidence submitted by the parties at the investigation. Therefore, those interested should either be present at the investigation or be represented by persons who may speak for them. Any records or written statements for consideration should be presented at the investigation.

If a staff analysis is prepared as a result of this investigation, recommendations on whether the application should be approved and terms and conditions to be imposed will be included. Unless a written request for a hearing is received within 30 days after the date of mailing the analysis, the State Water Resources Control Board will act on the application taking into consideration the recommendations in the analysis.
