APPLICATION 31491 OF FAHEY, WET MEADOWS SPRINGS
TRIBUTARY TO UNNAMED STREAM THENCE HULL CREEK AND
TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS TRIBUTARY TO UNNAMED STREAM THENCE
HULL CREEK IN TUOLUMNE COUNTY

The Division of Water Rights (Division) received the November 8, 2004 letter from the City and County of San Francisco (City) regarding the notice of Application 31491 dated October 1, 2004. The City requests an extension of time to file a protest in the event some issues cannot be resolved without a formal protest. However, since the City's letter was submitted in response to the notice, the Division will accept its letter as a protest.

The Division concurs with your statement that the City was not a party to the water exchange agreement dated December 30, 1992. As you pointed out, the City had a separate agreement with the applicant to resolve its protest.

You also pointed out that on April 25, 1995, applicant submitted a draft agreement with Tuolumne Utilities District (District) to the Division, but the Division did not approve it as indicated in its letter of June 14, 1995 and you request clarification that the updated water exchange agreement is inclusive of the quantities required under Permit 20784 and Application 31491. On July 28, 1995, the Division accepted part of agreement where imported water is released from Phoenix Lake into the Tuolumne River System specifically as replacement for water consumed in the project. The updated contract with the District, executed on October 20, 2003 is to purchase 41 acre-feet of water as a replacement water supply for years when diversion pursuant to Applications 31491 and 29977 is injurious to the Modesto and Turlock Districts' prior right. Application 31491 seeks authorization to divert 0.089 cubic foot per second (cfs). At this rate of diversion, total of 24.1 acre-feet will be diverted during the period from June 16 through October 31 (total of 137 days). Application 29977 (Permit 20784) is for 0.062 cfs, 16.8 acre-feet, during the same period. The total combined quantities under Applications 29977 and 31491 are 40.9 acre-feet.
