Ladies and Gentlemen:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

The requirements for submittal of closing briefs to the Douglas and Heidi Cole and Marble Mountain Ranch waste and unreasonable use hearing have been updated for all parties as follows:

- 1. The deadline to submit closing briefs is 12:00 noon on March 2, 2018 or 30 days following the date the transcripts are released, whichever is later.**
- 2. The page limit for closing briefs is 25 pages.**

The Division of Water Rights Prosecution Team (PT) requested postponement of the deadline to submit closing briefs and extension of the page limit for closing briefs by letters dated November 19 and 22, 2017, respectively.

As a reminder, closing briefs must be double-spaced and in 12-point Arial font.
