CORRECTION TO STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD DECISION 1647 PARTIALLY APPROVING WATER RIGHT APPLICATION 31174 OF THE ORANGE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT (OCWD), SANTA ANA RIVER

It has come to our attention that the above-referenced decision contains technical errors that affect the descriptions of the locations of Orange County Water District's (OCWD's) points of diversion (POD). Specifically, the coordinates for POD 7, which is a point of diversion and rediversion through the Santa Ana River bottom, were intended to describe the diversion as occurring along the river bottom between two points shown on a map included in OCWD's "Supplement to Orange County Water District Application to Appropriate Water by Permit, Submitted November 1992." Table 4, attached to Decision 1647, accurately described the section, township, and range of the upper POD 7 and the township and range of the lower POD 7. The California Coordinates, however, were incorrect for both points and the lower POD 7 should have been listed in section 19, instead of 18. In addition, POD 6 is in the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of section 7, rather than the NE ¼ of the NE ¼ of section 7. Finally, although the coordinates of POD 5 and POD 6 are correct, the landmark descriptions of the PODs should have been switched.

Pursuant to Water Code section 1124, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) "at any time may amend or modify a decision or order to correct any obvious typographical or clerical error or oversight . . ." The State Water Board has delegated this authority to the Deputy Director for Water Rights. (State Water Board Resolution No. 2007-0057, § 4.1.3.) In a letter dated October 4, 2007, the Deputy Director re-delegated this authority to the Assistant Deputy Director and to the Section Managers within each Section Manager's area of authority. (October 4, 2007 memorandum to All Water Rights Staff, § 4.1.3.)

Enclosed is a corrected Table 4, which includes the changes noted above. The corrected table replaces the original Table 4 on page 35 in State Water Board Decision 1647.


