Gentlemen:

Your letter of April 23rd has been received and in reply I wish to state that it is my opinion that use of water under both application 5169 and 5634 has been made to the extent contemplated and no increase in use is proposed.

In order that you may establish the measure of appropriative right initiated under the above applications, I am forwarding to you within a few days a schedule of Reservoir operations for the years 1944 and 1945. I will also enclose along with the schedules a copy of the Truckee River Agreement, which upon reading you will find that although water has been controlled in Boca primarily for conservation purposes and secondly for flood control that our storage rights to certain waters of the Little Truckee are junior in priority to those of the Government and to the Truckee Carson Irrigation District. In view of that fact I might add that it may not be necessary to file an application for flood control purposes. I will, however, present the matter to the Board of Directors at their next meeting on May 7th and will be only too glad to inform you of their decision.
