FIELD NOTES

Mr. Taylor interviewed in Reno.
It was found that normally all water stored in Boca
Res. which was not used within Dist. during its season was
transferred to Lahontan Res. in fall for use next season on
Truckee-Carson Project. It was pointed out to Mr. Taylor that
if this practice ^{was to be} continued a license covering the full storage
in Boca Res. could only be issued by assigning an interest
in the filing to the Truckee-Carson Project, naming Lahontan Res.
as a place of re-storage, including the Truckee-Carson
Project within the place of use under the filing and
describing the point of re-diversion from Truckee R. to Lahontan
Res. Mr. Taylor stated that these things would be done
and requested that it all be set up in a letter which
he could take to the June 5 meeting of the Dist. Bd.
of Directors.

Assignment and petition forms were left with him.
