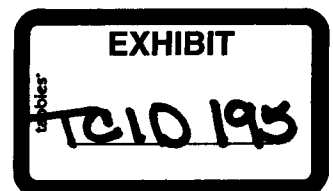



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5. Reclamation has a 1994 contract with the Truckee Meadows Water Authority, who now operates the system. The contract states, "Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 101-618, Section 205 (b)(1), the Secretary is authorized to use Washoe Project facilities, Truckee Storage Project facilities, and Lake Tahoe Dam and Reservoir for the storage of non-project water to fulfill the purposes of Public Law 101-618, Title II..." This contract is an interim storage agreement intended to provide some water to the Truckee Meadows until TROA can be negotiated.
